
For your convenience, textbooks may be purchased online through the <u>Campbell University Bookstore</u>.



Method of payment if you are not using a credit card will be CREEK BUCKS. You will enter your student ID number and submit payment. CREEK BUCKS essentially ties your student account with your purchase.

While you are not required to purchase your textbooks through Campbell University's bookstore, the book information is available for you just in case you decide to purchase your books through another venue.

For those who need loan money to pay for textbooks, the bookstore does offer the option of "floating" you the money to cover your book expense until your loan money is disbursed. To take advantage of this option, your loans must be in accepted status, complete, and ready to disburse at the time you submit your book order. Additionally, you will need to complete and return

the attached Authorization to Transfer Funds Form to the Campbell University Business Office by Wednesday, July  $\mathbf{1}^{\text{st}}$ . The appropriate fax number and email are listed on the form. Either fax or email is a sufficient delivery method.

You will receive multiple emails from the bookstore when the order has been submitted, processed and ready for pick up at the law school. *If you want your books in time for the first day of school, please place your order no later than Monday, August 3<sup>rd</sup>.* 

\*\* If funds are not available when a bookstore staff member attempts to fill the order, the bookstore will box your books and hold them for seven days after the first official day of class.
