**BIOL-286 HUMAN ANATOMY & PHYSIOLOGY II (4 Credits)**

The second semester of a two semester sequence of Human Anatomy and Physiology. This course covers organ systems and reproductive systems. Laboratory work/participation is essential to the understanding of the material presented in this course. This course is required for students in the fields of medicine, nursing, and biomedical sciences. BIOL 285 and BIOL 286 make up a two-semester sequence and both courses are required for the BS in Biology. Credit for BIOL 286 may not receive credit for BIOL 221.

**Requisites:**

BIOL-111 and BIOL-285 are prerequisites for this course. - Must be completed prior to taking this course. Take BIOL-286L with BIOL-286 - Must be taken at the same time as this course.
