

Campbell University Academic Achievement Award Criteria & Policies

Campbell University Academic Achievement Awards (CAA) are available to returning Campbell undergraduate students, who are not awarded any other institutional academic merit scholarships or awards. Campbell University Academic Achievement Awards are awarded based on student's hard work and dedication to academics at Campbell University.

The Office of Financial Aid initiates the academic review for eligible undergraduates. Students do not apply for this award, nor is it available for increase after award is applied to student's aid. Campbell University Achievement Awards are based on student's cumulative grade point average (CGPA). Presidential Scholarships, Scott-Ellis Scholarships, Campbell University Grants or Transfer Scholarships supersede all eligibility criteria of CAA.

- ❖ Campbell University Academic Achievement Awards are for Main Campus Undergraduate students attending Full Time (at least 12 credit hours) during Fall and Spring semesters only.
- ❖ The Campbell University Academic Achievement Awards are not transferrable to graduate or professional programs.
- ❖ Students must meet the CGPA requirement every semester.
- ❖ Students who have been awarded Hope previously, are not eligible for CAA.
- ❖ CAA may not be increased once awarded to student's aid.
- ❖ Students will NOT receive both academic merit scholarships and achievement awards.
- ❖ Award will be applied to tuition only and is not retroactive to previous semesters.
- ❖ CAA will be in effect for the period not to exceed eight full-time semesters, dating back to student's initial enrollment with the University.
- ❖ Campbell University Academic Achievement Awards are applicable to students with a cumulative grade point average of 2.5 or higher, that are not currently award academic merit scholarships.
