



Academic Merit Scholarship Eligibility Requirements

Campbell University Academic Merit Scholarships (Presidential Scholarship, Scott-Ellis Scholarship, and Campbell Grant) are for Main Campus Undergraduate students attending Full Time (at least 12 credits hours) during fall and spring semesters only. These scholarships are not transferrable to graduate or professional programs.

Below is a chart that indicates the minimum cumulative grade point average (CGPA) requirements.

Presidential Scholarship

End of second semester	CGPA 2.5 or better
End of fourth semester	CGPA 2.8 or better
End of second, fourth and sixth semester for Transfer Students	CGPA 3.0 or better
End of sixth semester	CGPA 3.0 or better

Must meet minimum 1.8 CGPA for any semester to receive Hope.

Hope may be awarded for ONE semester if not meeting minimum CGPA of Presidential Scholarship.

Scott-Ellis Scholarship

End of second semester	CGPA 2.5 or better
End of fourth semester	CGPA 2.8 or better
End of second, fourth, and sixth semester for Transfer students	CGPA 3.0 or better
End of sixth semester	CGPA 3.0 or better

Must meet minimum 1.8 CGPA for any semester to receive Hope.

Hope may be awarded for ONE semester if not meeting minimum CGPA of Scott-Ellis Scholarship.

Campbell Grant

Campbell Grant recipients must maintain a 2.0 CGPA during all semesters. Campbell Grants are not eligible for Hope.

Housing Scholarships and Other Aid

Campbell University on Campus Housing Scholarships are only available to students living on campus.

Students who do not maintain minimum CGPA of original Presidential or Scott-Ellis Scholarships are NOT eligible for Housing or any other grants/scholarships awarded by Admissions.

Faith Grant recipients are not eligible for Housing or Other Admission Scholarships.

If a student does not meet the Campbell University CGPA requirement for the Presidential Scholarship or Scott –Ellis Scholarship a Hope Scholarship may be awarded of equivalent value for ONE semester (requires min. 1.8cgpa). At the end of one semester of Hope, all eligibility criteria must be met for the original scholarship to be reinstated or the original scholarship will be canceled. A student may only receive the Hope Scholarship for one semester throughout their undergraduate career.

If a student’s CGPA is 2.0 or higher at the time the original award is cancelled, a Faith Grant may be awarded and the student must maintain eligibility as defined.

If a student meets the eligibility requirements after a scholarship has been cancelled, a student may request a scholarship review in writing to the Office of Financial Aid. Students attending summer terms to improve CGPA, must contact the OFA for new merit review. Standard terms of academic merit review are end of fall and spring each academic year.

All Campbell University institutional aid (scholarships, grants, campus-based funds) require a minimum 2.0 CGPA.

Hope Scholarship = Not an academic merit scholarship, only used to provide student ONE semester opportunity to improve.

Faith Grant = Aid allowed to supplement students loss of original academic merit scholarship due to GPA requirements.
