Understanding Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP)

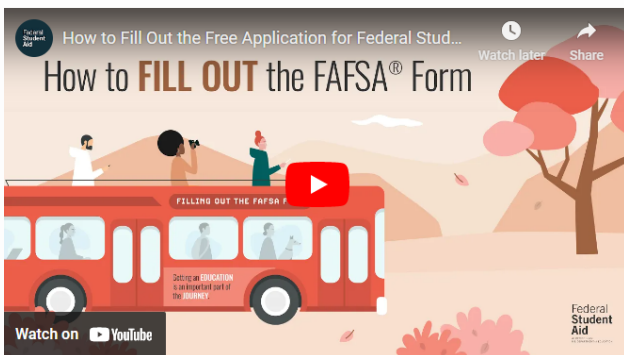
What is SAP? Every University that receives Federal Aid is required to have a SAP policy. A SAP policy is defined as, "the successful completion of coursework toward an eligible certificate or degree."

How does SAP affect you as a student? In order to receive federal or state aid; such as the Pell grant and NCNBS, you have to be passing SAP standards after every semester.

What are the SAP standards? As a student at Campbell University there are 3 basic measurements used to evaluate SAP:
1) Minimum cumulative GPA by year:

Academic Level	Credits Attempted	GPA
Freshman	1 – 23	1.4
Sophomore	24 – 39	1.6
Junior	40 – 63	1.8
Senior	64 or more	2.0

- 2) Each semester you must successfully complete at least 67% of the cumulative credit hours attempted.
3) You can only receive federal aid for up to 150% of the length of your program of study.
