



2026-2027 New Student Housing Assignment Process

Live-On Requirement

Campbell University is a residential campus where undergraduate students are required to live on campus for 6 continuous semesters. Unmarried undergraduate students under the age of 21, who do not live with their parents/guardians, must live on campus.

Exceptions only include students who have an approved [Off-Campus Housing Request Form](#) on file and students who have fulfilled the live-in requirement. For housing purposes, a transfer student is defined as a student that completed high school, enrolled at and attended another institution, and then enrolled at Campbell University. Transfer students will be considered on an individual basis.

Helpful Definitions and Information

Roommate Group: Students who would like to live together may form a roommate group. One student must be the group leader and create a roommate group, then invite their desired roommates to join the group as a member. Students must individually accept their roommate group invitation in the housing portal to become a member of the roommate group.

While we do our best to accommodate roommate requests, we cannot guarantee availability to do so.

New Student: Students who have not attended Campbell University before or any 2-year or 4-year college. Students who have college credits from being dual-enrolled during high school fall into this category.



Transfer Student: For housing purposes, a transfer student is defined as a student that completed high school, enrolled at, and attended, another college or university, and is transferring from that college to Campbell University. If you have only attended college through dual-enrollment while in high school, you are not considered a transfer student.

Current Student: Students currently attending Campbell University as a commuter or residential student during the current semester.

Student-Athletes: Students who are a member of an athletic team managed by the Athletics department. Athletics determines where student-athletes living on campus are assigned.

Housing Application Access

New students will fall into one of two categories, priority and general, which will dictate when your access to the housing application begins. All students must complete a housing application to be considered for occupancy of Campbell University housing.

Priority Housing Application Access

New students who were admitted to Campbell University by November 15, 2025, **and** paid their [Enrollment Deposit](#) by January 15, 2026, will gain access to the housing application beginning February 17, 2026.

General Housing Application Access

Students who do not meet the requirements for all other new students will gain access to the housing application beginning February 24, 2026.



Housing Placement Dates

March 25: Deadline to complete Housing Application to be placed in First Round of housing assignments.

April 8: Emails sent to students placed in First Round of housing assignments notifying them that they have been placed.

April 15: Deadline to complete Housing Application to be placed in Second Round of Housing assignments.

April 29: Emails sent to students placed in Second Round of housing assignments notifying them that they have been placed.

May 6: Deadline to complete Housing Application to be placed in Third Round of housing assignments.

May 20: Emails sent to students placed in Third Round of housing assignments notifying them that they have been placed.

May 27-August 14: Students who submit the Housing Application after May 6 will be placed on a weekly basis. Emails will be sent to students notifying them that they have been placed.
