Investigation: pre-investigation initiated October 7-9, 2025 and a full investigation began on November 4, 2025. Findings completed on April 22, 2026.

Finding: Hazing

Violation Summary: The organization was found to have violated the university Anti-Hazing Policy with hazing behaviors within the living community housed on the same floor in a campus residence hall during a period of August 2025 – October 2025. Concerns included conduct for the purposes of “maintenance of membership” that included entering rooms without permission through “carding”, taking personal property without permission through “preeshing”, pouring water and Sprite on first year students, leaving urine and feces in rooms, and punishment to first year students for personal activity considered not in alignment with the program. The residence learning community leadership agreed to a one year pause of the community in a residence hall as well as training and education for students and leaders to ensure a safer and welcoming environment.

Sanctions and Action Plan:

- One year pause of the residence living community
- Apology notes to fellow members of the RLC and program leaders
- List education/training plan for PGM and Res Life
