Withdrawal from a Course

Students must officially **withdraw from a class to avoid receiving a grade of "F"** for the class and being charged for the class. Students must drop the class by **January 22, 2018** to receive a full refund. Students must drop class by **March 23, 2018** to receive a W. Any class dropped after **March 23, 2018** will receive an F.

An official form for withdrawing from a course may be obtained in the Academic Dean Office (room 129). To receive a full refund, the student must complete the withdrawal process prior to the beginning of the second class meeting.
