Summer school courses are offered primarily for concentration and elective studies. Students may take up to nine hours. **Advance matriculation will be April 9 –April 27 and may be completed in person or by mail. For those taking a classroom course, matriculation and payment of fees may also be done on May 22 – 24.** A late matriculation fee will apply after May 24. The last time to add a course is before the second class meeting. The last time to drop a course without a grade notation and for a full refund is May 26.

- DIVI-3259 Jesus in the Pluralistic Age** (1hr.) Oladipo. July 26-27

- DIVI-6031/CEDU641 Life-Span Development**, (3 hrs.) Moran. This class is offered in conjunction with the School of Education; *enrollment is limited to professor’s approval.* This is an online class. **Classes begin on Monday, May 21 and end on Friday, June 22, 2018.**
- DIVI-5649/CEDU685 Spirituality, Religion, & Diversity for Professional Counselors**, (3 hrs.) Wagstaff. This class is offered in conjunction with the School of Education; enrollment is limited to professor approval. This class meets on Tuesday/Thursday Starting **Tuesday, June 25 from 4:30 – 7:30 in Taylor Hall 218.** The last class will be on Thursday, July 26.

The following courses meet off-campus:

- DIVI-5475 Clinical Pastoral Education** (½ unit in an approved program - 4 hrs. credit) Dr. Hogan, days and times TBA. Prerequisite: **DIVI 5400 Pastoral Care.** (*Acceptance in an approved program and approval by the course professor required by May 14. A letter/certificate of completion and an evaluation report are due by Monday, August 6.*)
- DIVI-5476 Clinical Pastoral Education** (½ unit in an approved program - 4 hrs. credit) Dr. Hogan, days and times TBA. Prerequisite: **DIVI 5475.** (*Acceptance in an approved program and approval by the course professor required by May 14. A letter/certificate of completion and an evaluation report are due by Monday, August 6.*)

Field-based courses (approval by May 12 required)

The following courses are self-directed and may be conducted at any time during the summer. They are field-based, require advance preparation, and involve 100-150 hours of on-site work/learning experiences. Approval in advance is required. Students complete an approved project and develop a journal and notebook following course guidelines. Information will be provided, but arrangements and expenses will be your responsibility. **Contracts are available in the Divinity School office and must be approved by the course professor or Assistant Dean by May 14. Reports are due in the Divinity School Office by Monday, August 6.**
