

Bible Land Study Tour 2020: Greece, Ephesus, and the Greek Isles

Join Dr. Andy Wakefield and Dr. Alicia Myers on a trip to Greece, Ephesus, and the Greek Isles on May 10-20, 2020. We will visit many of the places where Paul went on his second and third missionary journeys, including Thessaloniki, Philippi, Athens, Corinth, and a cruise across the Aegean Sea to Ephesus. Ephesus is also a traditional Johannine site, and on our return cruise, we will visit the island of Patmos, where John experienced the visions that are recorded in Revelation. Along the way we will also have the chance to visit many ancient Greek sites, including Delphi, the ancient village of Akrotiri (preserved by a volcanic eruption in 1500 BC), the grave of Philip of Macedonia, and more.

This trip is open to anyone, but students have first priority--and students get a generous discount as well!
