Campbell University is closely monitoring the spread of COVID-19. Classes have all moved online. Please keep an eye on your email and on Blackboard for further updates. Prevention remains the key strategy for containing this virus and minimizing your risk of infection. Here are a few of the suggested actions to reduce the risk.
