**Withdrawal from a Course**

Students must officially *withdraw from a class to avoid receiving a grade of "F"* for the class and being charged for the class. Students must drop the class **by 5:00 pm on August 27th** to receive a full refund. Students must drop the class by 5:00 pm. on October 28th to receive a W. Any class dropped after 5:00 pm. October 28th will receive an F.

An official form for withdrawing from a course may be obtained in the Academic Dean Office (room 129). The form must be returned to Elaine Dawson in room 129 or by mail to PO Drawer 4050, Buies Creek, NC 27506. It is the responsibility of the student to obtain all necessary signatures. To receive a full refund, the student must complete the withdrawal process prior to the beginning of the second class meeting.
