This additional teaching allows her to mentor women discerning their call to pastoral ministry.

Andrea graduated from Rhodes College in Memphis and earned a master of divinity degree from Mercer University's McAfee School of Theology. She later finished her doctorate in ministry from Baptist Theological Seminary at Richmond. Andrea met her husband, Brent, while they both attended seminary at McAfee. Brent also finished a doctorate, specializing in American religious history at the University of Virginia.
