### Instructions:

1. **Schedule:** Copies of the Fall 2026 Course Schedules are attached. Please complete the following steps as you fill out your schedule:
  - Circle the courses you wish to take. Note that some courses appear on the back of the schedule sheet. You are encouraged to discuss your choices with your faculty advisor if you have any questions.
  - Fill out the form, **noting the number of hours you wish to take. Make sure you include your ID number, sign, and date your schedule.**
  - Turn in your schedule to Elaine Dawson in Taylor 129 according to the matriculation schedule above.

***\*Please be aware that if you have an outstanding balance on your account, you will not be able to be registered for classes until your balance is paid.***

2. **Scholarship Award Process:**

***Note: Tuition for the Summer 2026 term will remain at \$670 per credit hour. All students will receive 100% financial assistance coverage for Summer 2026.***

- a. A Summer 2026 and Fall 2026 Tuition and Fees Worksheet has been included to assist you with calculating charges based on the number of hours for which you register. (see below)
- b. **Reminder:** Over the summer, each student that has submitted a Fall 2026 registration form will receive an award letter indicating his/her scholarship percentage award for the 2026-2027 academic year. Along with the award letter, there will also be an acceptance form that needs to be completed. Each student will use this form to accept the scholarship percentage award, agree to the conditions of the award, and let the Divinity School know of any outside scholarships he/she expects to receive for the upcoming year. If a student does not register for Fall 2026 courses during the advance matriculation period, the student will receive his/her award letter and acceptance form after he/she registers.
- c. **Payment Options:** By the end of July, your student account should be up-to-date with your total charges for the Fall 2026 semester. Before you make a payment, please make sure you

refer to your scholarship award letter that you will receive closer to the beginning of the Spring semester to make sure you know the amount you will owe once your scholarship awards are applied to your account. Please remember to consider any outside scholarships you are expecting to receive when calculating your remaining balance. Divinity School scholarship awards will not be applied to students' accounts until the beginning of the Fall 2026 semester. The University's Bursar's Office will send out statements and will notify you of payment deadlines. Payment options are listed below.

1. **Check or Cash Payment** can be made *directly* to the Bursar's Office. The balance will need to be paid by the first day of class.
2. **Online Payment** can be made through Campbell's PayMyTuition, which can be accessed through the Self-Service Portal. The balance will need to be paid by the first day of class.
3. **A Payment Plan can be setup with the Bursar's Office.** If you would like to set up a Payment Plan, you must do so by August 3, 2026. You can learn more about payment plans at <https://www.campbell.edu/bursars-office/payments/payment-plans/>.
4. **You can apply for a student loan to pay for tuition.** Completion of the FAFSA is required for student loan consideration. Loans are processed through the University's Financial Aid Office, not through the Divinity School.
