PROGRAM DESCRIPTION:

The Graduate Botanical and Holistic Health Certificate program is an online 12-semester-credit-hour certificate that equips post-professionals with skills and expertise in the area of integrative/holistic health to positively impact the general wellbeing of patients.

ADMISSIONS REQUIREMENTS:

- A minimum of a Bachelor's Degree (in a science field) from an accredited US institution with a minimum GPA of 3.0.
- Must satisfy Campbell University General Admission Requirements and submit a complete application form.

MISCELLANEOUS INFORMATION:

- **Transfer Credit:** This program permits NO transfer credit of any kind.
- **Completion Requirements:** All students earning a Graduate Certificate in Botanical and Holistic Health must earn 12 semester hours of credit (of which all must be taken at Campbell University), and any additional requirements satisfied in order to obtain the certificate. Students must complete the curriculum requirements with a grade of "C" or higher in each course.

ADVISER NOTES:

Residency Requirements: Students must complete a minimum of 12 semester hours of Campbell University courses.
