Dear AOE Faculty Member,

Alpha Sigma Lambda is offering **six (6) scholarships of \$3000 and fifteen (15) scholarships of \$2500** each to students who will be enrolled in the 2022-23 academic year. Each college with an Alpha Sigma Lambda chapter may submit two applications. There are currently over 300 chapters in the U.S. but less than half of them submit applications. We want our students to be in that number!

Your student is contacting you because she or he meets the minimum requirements to apply. The scholarships are available for students with at least one semester remaining to complete their degree and who meet the following criteria:

- Completed 24 semester hours of graded coursework at Campbell. (Not including transfers.)
- Achieved a grade point average of **3.2** on all work taken at Campbell.
- Is enrolled in an associate's or a baccalaureate degree program at Campbell.
- Has a financial need for assistance to complete the degree.
- At least one semester of coursework remaining. The scholarship is for the 2023-24 academic year, which begins in August 2023.

The student must submit an application packet containing a personal statement as well as a Faculty Recommendation Form from a faculty member at Campbell University. The student may present you with the Faculty Recommendation Form or it can be accessed on the [Campbell Alpha Sigma Lambda Scholarship](#) website under the "Helpful Links" heading.

The strength of the faculty recommendation is absolutely critical to students earning this scholarship. It asks you to comment on the following areas:

- Personal qualities/challenges (e.g., attitude, commitment)
- Promise as a student and graduate (can include personal management skills, communication skills, scholastic effort)
- Leadership/service to community (campus, academic or local)
- Career potential/promise to their chosen profession
- Personal observations/comments (in particular, any financial need, personal qualities, or challenges they deal with)

Please expand on each area, if you have observed them.
