MISCELLANEOUS INFORMATION:

- Official Evaluation of Transfer Credit: Students are added to the Official Evaluation Queue after the receipt of all official transcripts of previous education and/or military training and/or college-level testing.
- Transfer Credit: Campbell University will accept a maximum of 64 semester hours in transfer from any combination of regionally accredited twoyear colleges, ACE-recommended lower level military credit, and/or CLEP/DANTES. There is no limit on the number of semester hours accepted from ACE-recommended upper level military and/or CLEP/DANTES credit, or credit from an accredited four-year institution.
- Residency Requirements: Students must complete a minimum of 15.5 semester hours of Campbell University courses.
- Graduation Requirements: All students earning Associate degrees must have a minimum of 62 semester hours and all degree requirements met in order to graduate. Students are required to have a minimum GPA of 2.0 in their major AND overall to graduate.
- Waived Courses: In the event a course is waived, the credit hours must be made up in electives.

¹ Campbell Seminar: Students MUST pass COSU 100 in their first term with Campbell University and it MUST be taken at their home campus. ² Fine Arts: "Appreciation," "Introduction," or "Survey" course in art, music, or theatre; "History" courses do not meet this requirement (e.g., "History")

² Fine Arts: "Appreciation," "Introduction," or "Survey" course in art, music, or theatre; "History" courses do not meet this requirement (e.g., "History of Art").

³ English/Math: Students are required to take ENGL 100 and MATH 110 (as pre-requisite ENGL/MATH courses), unless documentation is provided showing one of the following: minimum SAT/ACT Score(s), minimum ACCUPLACER placement test score(s), completion of previous college-level ENGL/MATH course(s). MATH Elective(s) must be numbered MATH 111 College Algebra or MATH 112 Trigonometry or above.

⁴ Literature Elective: The ENGL LIT requirement may be satisfied by completing one of the following literature courses: ENGL 201, 202, 203, 204, 205, or 206. (Or with a 300 level Foreign LANG LIT.)

⁵ **Sciences:** Students preparing for transfer into the BS in Biological Sciences or similar BS/BHS degree should select from the following courses: BIOL (111, 201, or 220), or CHEM 111.

⁶ *Humanities/Social Science Elective:* Choose one of the following: CHRS (202, 212, 224, 236, 251, 322 or higher), PHIL 121, ENGL (201, 202, 203, 204, 205, or 206), HIST (100 or above), Foreign Language (101, 102, 201, 202, 221, 222, 241, or 242), CRIM, ECON, GEOG, POLS, PSYC, SOCI. or COMM 240.

⁷ **PSYC Electives:** Choose from the following: PSYC (232, 260, or 267).
