¹ **Campbell Seminar:** Students MUST pass COSU 100 in their first term with Campbell University and it MUST be taken at their home campus.

MISCELLANEOUS INFORMATION:

- **Official Evaluation of Transfer Credit:** Students are added to the Official Evaluation Queue after the receipt of all official transcripts of previous education and/or military training and/or college-level testing.
- **Transfer Credit:** Campbell University will accept a maximum of 6 semester hours in transfer from any combination of regionally accredited colleges, ACE-recommended lower level military credit, and CLEP/DANTES.
- **Residency Requirements:** Students must complete a minimum of 12 semester hours of Campbell University courses.
- **Completion Requirements:** All students earning a Certificate in Christian Studies must complete the required number of semester hours specific to the program, residency requirements met, and any additional requirements satisfied in order to obtain the certificate. Students are required to have a minimum overall GPA of 2.0.
- **Waived Courses:** In the event a course is waived, the credit hours must be made up in electives.
- **Financial Aid:** Students enrolling in the Christian Studies Certificate will not be eligible for Title IV financial aid. Students can still pursue private scholarship or loan opportunities to financially support completion of the program.
