¹ **Practicing the edTPA:** EDUC 519 is a prerequisite for EDUC 700, there are no exceptions.

PROGRAM DESCRIPTION:

The Master of Arts in Teaching program is an online 30-semester-credit-hour program that provides essential teaching skills and a firm foundation in the theories, principles and practical applications necessary for teaching and leadership success. The program also emphasizes skill development in collaboration, communication, critical thinking, problem solving, empathy and cultural sensitivity. For college graduates from any background who wish to earn a Master's degree and eligibility to apply for NC Teacher Licensure. Two of the 10 courses do require in-person internship experience in a classroom for residency licensure.

ADMISSIONS REQUIREMENTS:

- A minimum of a Bachelor's Degree in any field from an accredited US institution with a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5.
- Must satisfy Campbell University General Admission Requirements and submit a complete application form.
- No standardized tests such as GREs are required for full admission.

MISCELLANEOUS INFORMATION:

- **Transfer Credit:** Transfer of graduate credit (if any, and if appropriate) is upon approval of the Dean. The request should be made before starting course work in the program and a maximum of 6 semester hours of transfer credit will be accepted.
- **Graduation Requirements:** All students earning a Master of Arts in Teaching degree must have a minimum of 30 semester hours of credit and all degree requirements met in order to graduate. Students must complete the curriculum requirements with a 3.0 average or better with no more than two grades of C. Three grades of C or one grade of F will lead to academic dismissal. Completion of all curriculum requirements must be within a five-calendar year period of time. Under extenuating circumstances, an extension may be requested from the Dean. The candidate is responsible for applying for graduation through the Registrar's webpage via the graduation link and all financial obligations must be satisfied prior to graduation.
