ANNUAL SCHOLARSHIPS

***CPHS Alumni Association Scholarship** – This scholarship is awarded to a full-time student based on financial need and GPA. Preference is given to students who are actively involved with PASA and/the CPHS Alumni Association. Scholarships are selected by the CPHS Alumni Association. Essay is required to be eligible.

(Prompt: Complete a 500-750 word essay on how the CPHS Alumni Association and/or the Professional Alumni Student Association (PASA) can have a larger impact on our students and alumni from your academic program. Nurses First Annual Scholarship – This scholarship is awarded to a nursing student who meets the following criteria: is a first generation college student, comes from a rural background, and has a GPA of 3.0 or higher.

***Ransdell Family Fund Scholarship** – This scholarship emphasizes advancement of pharmacy healthcare in North Carolina counties experiencing a shortage of pharmacy professionals. It is awarded to a full-time student in good academic standing with a 2.5 or higher GPA and demonstrated financial need. The student must agree to work in an underserved community upon graduation for three (3) years total. Students must express a desire to bring adequate healthcare to a rural population. Visit the [NC State Education Assistance Authority](#) for information on counties with primary care physician shortages. Essay is required to be eligible.

(Prompt: Complete a 500 word or less essay indicating motivation, career goals, and stating the reasons why you desire to work in a health profession serving an underserved community after graduation (see scholarship descriptions on our website for awarding criteria/)

School of Nursing Scholarship – This scholarship is awarded to a nursing student who meets the following criteria: is a first generation college student, comes from a rural background, and has a GPA of 3.0 or higher.

ENDOWED SCHOLARSHIPS

Anne Alphin Hobson Department of Nursing Undergraduate Scholarship – This scholarship is awarded to student(s) who is enrolled in the College of Pharmacy and Health Sciences, Department of Nursing (BSN) Program. Preference shall be given to students who are a graduate of a high school in Harnett County; students who are a graduate of a high school in Johnston or Sampson County; then scholarship committee selection.

Dr. Marie Mason School of Nursing Endowed Scholarship – This scholarship is awarded to a student(s) pursuing a degree in nursing. First preference awarded to student(s) from Hyde County. Second preference, to student(s) from North Carolina. Third preference to student(s) selected from the Scholarship Committee.

Lloyd S. Surles Department of Nursing Scholarship – This scholarship is awarded to a student enrolled in the Nursing program. Preference is given to students from Harnett County, then North Carolina, then any qualified.

Edward B. Titmus School of Nursing Scholarship - This scholarship is awarded to a nursing major who demonstrates financial need, is a resident of VA or resident of NC is VA is not available.
